Titus and Philippians 1:20

On Wednesday we will look at Titus in depth over 3 weeks:

Students will answer questions first and will not only write down but put the verse next to their answer. We will look at how to ask good questions while reading the Bible.

We will divide the group and have leader facilitate the discussion and together leaders and students will digging in the Bible to find the answers.

Take some time and sit down with your MS or HS student and look at what they have learned.

On Sunday we will study Philippians 1:20 for 5 weeks.

We will break down the verse is broken down into five sections talking about:

- -) not being shameful of our God
- -) the amount of courage that is needed to follow and live for our God
- -) Being a "now as always" type of person
- -) answer the "how magnified is God in your life?"
- -)how you are living your life for God and what it might look like when you are no longer living.

We will work on making those observations from the Bible, write them down, we will also try to answer questions about everyday life as it pertains to Philippians 1:20.


